Why a book gift -program?

Finland still ranks number one as the most literate country in the world. Children and adolescents excel in PISA (2015 3rd) and PIRLS (2016 5th) **BUT**

Attitudes towards reading are changing:

Motivation and enthusiasm expressed by children and adolescents is one of the **lowest** in the world.

Also parents' attitude towards reading has recently become more negative = PIRLS 2011 **9%** vs. 2017 **16%**

Proportion of weak readers has risen from 7% (PISA 2011) to 11% (PISA 2015 11%, boys 16%).

Why maternity and child health care centers?

The goal is to provide book bag -program to all families regardless their social or economic background.

Maternity and child health care centers are **free of charge** and **easy to reach** for clients in every municipality in health care center

Widely used and accepted regardless of social class, **obligatory** to receive financial support = **99,4** % of families use these services

- 50 000 children born per year
- 8-9 visits during the normal course of a pregnancy
- 10 visits during the first year of an infant's life and once a year after that (1-6 years)
- 420 000 children under school age (0-6 years)











Would you want to give out materials to families?




Do you believe a book gift would inspire families to read?




